Computer Classes

Register

Register at the Main Library Information Desk, 1st floor, or by telephone at 310-412-5380. Registrations are first come, first served. Those registering will need to leave their name, phone number and Library Card number. If you do not register or are placed on the Waiting List, we cannot guarantee there will be space available as classes are limited to 10 students. Those wishing to attend classes need to be in the lab no more than five minutes after scheduled times. Except for the Computers Basics classes, users should be able to use a mouse and keyboard with some familiarity and should have a basic understanding of the Windows operating system.

Classes

Check the monthly class calendar to see if the class you want is scheduled.

Introduction to Computers. This class includes an explanation of the parts of a computer and simple tasks.

Internet for Beginners. Learn how access to this tool can enrich your life.

Using E-mail. Learn how to send and receive e-mail using free e-mail providers. Students should have some Internet experience.

Word for Beginners. Learn to write and edit documents using Microsoft Word. Students should have some computer experience.

Excel Parts 1 and 2. Learn to create and edit spreadsheets, useful for all numeric analysis and bookkeeping purposes. Students should have some experience using a word processing program.

Finding Books and Information. Find books, magazine, newspaper articles, practice civil service and career test exams using online databases.

PowerPoint. Create print presentations or slide shows using templates and images.

Social Networking. Learn how to use MySpace, Facebook, Wikipedia . . .

Open Lab

The Gates Computer Lab is open for general use Mon., Tues., and Wed. from 1:00 p.m. to 7:45 p.m., Thurs. from 1:00 p.m. to 5:45 p.m., Sat. from 10 :00 a.m. to 1:45 p.m., and closed on Fri. and Sun. Users are limited to one hour per day and must show their valid Inglewood Public Library Card. Staff can provide only minimum quidance. It is now possible to schedule an hour of computer use in advance at Library reservation terminals.
