The Cultural Section offers a variety of cultural classes and activities which are representative of Inglewood's diverse ethnic and age populations.

DANCE CLASSES

Fantasia Dance Ensemble provides dance instruction to children, teens and adults ages 2 and up. The combination class covers all styles of dance including; tap, ballet, jazz, modern, African and hip-hop. Classes are held on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Veterans Memorial Building located at 330 Centinela Avenue in Inglewood. The cost is \$26 per month, per student. Class is taught by instructor Alicia Littleton.

Ballet Folklorico provides instruction in the art of Mexican folk dance to youth and adults ages 5 and up. Participants learn basic footwork, dance and performance techniques. Beginning classes are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. at the Veterans Memorial Building located at 330 Centinela Avenue in Inglewood. The cost is \$27 per month, per student. Class is taught by instructor Daniel Macias.
