Restoration Funding for the Helen Lundeberg Mural “The History of Transportation”

Almost two million dollars in funding has been awarded to the City of Inglewood to fund the restoration of “the History of Transportation” mural by California artist Helen Lundeberg.

- The J. Paul Getty Grant Program Planning Grant
 - The Preserve L.A. Program provides funds to conserve landmark buildings and sites of architectural, cultural and historic significance.
 - Award; \$50,000
- Urban Recreational and Cultural Centers (URCC) program
 - The State Department of Parks and Recreation administers the funds from this competitive grant for restoration of historic properties.
 - Award: \$621,000
- The California Heritage Fund Grant
 - The Office of Historic Preservation administers the funds from this competitive grant for historic and archeological preservation projects.
 - Award: \$200,000
- The California Cultural and Historic Endowment (CCHE)
 - The California State Library administers the funds from this competitive grant for Preserving historic and cultural resources
 - Award: \$160,000
- The Park Bond Acts of 2000 and 2002, Roberti-Z’berg-Harris and Per Capita funds
 - Award: \$825,000
- Funds from the City of Inglewood, corporations, businesses and individuals
 - Award: \$150,000
