Homelessness Prevention & Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) Guidelines

The City of Inglewood’s Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) is a “needs-based” assistance program designed to provide short-term assistance to individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless due to financial hardship brought on by the recent economic downturn. Due to limited funding, the City of Inglewood will not be able to help everyone who is homeless or at risk of eviction.

The following are the **minimum eligibility requirements** for a household to be considered for the City of Inglewood HPRP program:

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or a legal permanent resident (with proper documentation)
- Must be a resident of the City of Inglewood
- Must be employable or able to remain employed
- Must either be homeless or at risk of becoming homeless (according to HUD's definition of homelessness) AND
 - Have no appropriate subsequent housing options AND
 - Must lack the financial resources and support networks needed to obtain immediate housing or remain in existing housing
- Must be willing to participate in a comprehensive case management plan.
- Household income must be at 50% or below of the Area Median Income (AMI) as shown below (Priority will be given to those below 30% AMI):

Household Size	Extremely Low (30%)	Very Low (50%)
1 Person	\$16,650	\$27,750
2 Person	\$19,050	\$31,700
3 Person	\$21,400	\$35,700
4 Person	\$23,800	\$39,650
5 Person	\$25,700	\$42,800

Rental Assistance:

Short-term	One time security deposit assistance	0-3 months rental assistance
Medium-term	Up to 6 months past due rental assistance- counted against 18 month term of service	4-18 months rental assistance
Hotel/Motel Vouchers	Up to 30 nights	Provided in 1 week increments

* **Note:** Clients must pay 30% of their income toward rent each month.

Utilities Assistance:

- One time turn-on fee
- One time security deposit assistance
- Up to 6 months past due assistance to bring current
