 - a) An advertised public hearing to consider proposed amendments to Chapter 12 of the Inglewood Municipal Code that would allow the tear down of one or more billboards in certain areas of the City of Inglewood in exchange for the ability to install a fewer number of signs in another area that is near a freeway or on a major or minor arterial street subject to Special Use Permit approval and to consider other revisions that would apply to billboard signs. On January 7, 2009, the Planning Commission approved Resolution No. 1547 to recommend City Council approval of an ordinance to ban billboards city-wide. On February 24, 2009 the City Council referred the matter back to the Planning Commission to consider allowing the replacement or exchange of billboard sign area when a greater amount of billboard sign area is removed.
6. A presentation with request by staff and the General Plan Update consultant for the Planning Commission to make a determination of complete for a Final Fiscal Report, a Final Traffic Report, Preliminary Natural Resources Policy Paper and Preliminary Utilities and Community Services Policy Paper that may be used to develop revised City of Inglewood General Plan Elements that are being developed for the Inglewood General Plan Update project. The reports and policy papers reflect comments and recommendations that were previously made by the City Council, Planning Commission, and the public during previous meetings and community workshops.
