PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY PLAN AND
RESIDENT ADVISORY BOARD (RAB)**

In accordance with Section 511 of the Public Housing Reform Act, the Inglewood Housing Authority (IHA) has developed its Annual Plan FY2010-2011. The purpose of the Plan is to advise HUD, members of the public and Section 8 participants of the IHA's mission for serving the needs of very low-income families in the City of Inglewood and the strategy for addressing those needs. The proposed Plan is available for public review starting March 3, 2010. Copies of the Plan may be reviewed at the Inglewood Main Library and the IHA office at One W. Manchester Blvd., Suite 750.

In accordance with the Public Housing Reform Act and 24 CFR (Code of Federal Regulations) Part 903 regulations on Resident Advisory Board (RAB) meetings, the IHA's annual RAB meeting will be held on Thursday, April 22, 2010 at 6:00 P.M. in the Library Lecture Hall located in the library courtyard, One W. Manchester Blvd. The purpose of this annual meeting is to give participants the opportunity to make recommendations regarding the Plan. All adult participants of the Inglewood Section 8 Program are members of RAB and are encouraged to attend and comment on the Plan.
