ROBBERY OF U.S. POST OFFICE, HILLCREST STATION

On April 1, 2009, at approximately 6:15 PM the post office located on 300 E. Hillcrest Blvd., Inglewood, CA was robbed by two male suspects.

Description:

SUSPECT #1 Male, black, dark complexion, 6'5, solid build 25-35 years old, last seen wearing dark blue mask and dark colored hooded sweater, dark shoes and black gloves.

SUSPECT #2 Male, black, lighter complexion than SUSPECT #1, 5'7, slight build, 25 years old wearing a dark colored mask and dark clothing.
