## \$25,000 REWARD

The City of Inglewood is offering a **reward up to \$25,000** for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person involved in the below described incident:

On Sunday, May 11, 2008, at approximately 1:40AM, a male suspect was observed shooting a handgun in the parking lot adjacent to the Rally's Burger located at Crenshaw and Manchester Boulevards. The suspect's criminal actions set in motion a chain of events, which resulted in the tragic death of a 19 year old subject at that location.

Witnesses described the suspect as an African American Male, 25 to 29 years of age, 5'9" to 5'11", 135 to 150lbs. The suspect was wearing a white T-shirt and dark pants, and he was armed with an unknown type handgun. The suspect fled the location as police officers arrived to investigate the shooting.
