The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance of the City's infrastructure. Public Works staff oversees the City's **solid waste** and **recycling services**, maintains **streets, sidewalks** and the City's **fleet**, provides **permits** and Geographic Information System (**GIS**) **mapping** services, and provides for and operates the City's **water** supply and **stormwater** systems. The Public Works Department provides several hotlines to the public.

Scavenging Hotline 310-680-5011

Taking recyclables is against the law! It is prohibited for persons to take recyclables from residents' and business owners' blue recycling bins. If you notice this happening in your neighborhood, please report it. The City also provides "Smart Tips" to determine the best way to rectify this situation.

Graffiti Hotline 310-412-8739

When Community Services Inspectors locate unreported graffiti, they initiate a report that includes a comprehensive description of the graffiti, paint color(s), names, numbers and/or other vandalism portrayed. Photographs of the graffiti are taken to be used as evidence in the event that the responsible person is apprehended. The Inspectors then notify our Neighborhood Services Graffiti Removal Program, through which the graffiti is obliterated. The graffiti will be removed/painted over by the City, free of charge.

Litter Hotline 310-412-5491

When Community Services Inspectors locate unreported litter or incidences of illegal dumping, they will initiate immediate abatement actions. Photographs of the illegal dumping are taken to be used as evidence in the event the responsible person is apprehended. The Investigators then notify our Property Maintenance Crews, who will remove and discard the debris.

Parking Meters are situated throughout the City and are maintained by the Public Works Department's Parking Meter Crew. The Meter Crew is currently engaged in a comprehensive program dedicated to upgrading and modernizing the City's over 1,600 parking meters! Some of the results are already noticeable: standardized parking meter rates, improved parking meter security and a reduction in vandalism.

The City's Stormwater Runoff Investigation Unit (SRI) is responsible for the enforcement of the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) under the Federal Clean Water Act. The SRI Unit is hard at work safeguarding storm drains from hazardous runoff material that drains to and pollutes coastal beaches.
