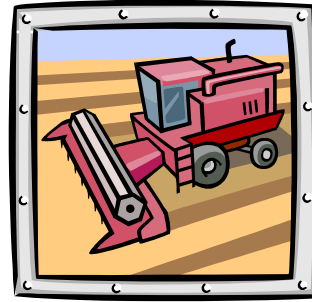

Fleet Services Division
Fleet Facts*



The Fleet Services Division consists of 12 employees who support various department/divisions: Superintendent, Supervisor, Administrative Analyst, Administrative Fleet Specialist, 4 Fleet Maintenance Mechanics, 3 Heavy Equipment Mechanics and 1 Custodial Equipment Worker.

The Fleet Services Division is responsible for repairing and maintaining vehicles and equipment for over 50 departments which include: the Police Department, Water and Sewer, Street Division, Facilities, Public Transportation and Motor Pool.

The Fleet Services Division administers the equipment replacement program and vehicle operating budgets. This includes evaluation of equipment for replacement, preparation of specifications necessary for the acquisition of effective and productive equipment, and the disposal of vehicles and equipment to be sold at auction.

Other responsibilities include: the annual California Highway Patrol (CHP) vehicle inspections; the annual CAL-OSHA crane safety inspections, Southern California Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) reports and the operation, maintenance and repairs for equipment including fuel storage, monitoring systems, the City's carwash system and the automated fueling systems both gasoline and Compress Natural Gas (CNG) system.
