Dear Community Leader:

Recognizing your leadership role in your community, we would like you to be one of the first to know about a free Household Hazardous Waste and E-Waste Roundup being conducted by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works and the Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County in your community. The program is free to all residents of your community and is designed to provide them with a convenient and legal way to rid their homes of many household hazardous waste and e-waste items that may have accumulated over time.

A free Household Hazardous Waste and E-Waste Roundup is scheduled to take place in Inglewood on October 27, 2007 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Attached is information on the event which should answer most of your questions.

For the nineteenth consecutive year, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works and the Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County have been working closely with officials from communities such as yours to ensure that residents are made aware of opportunities to dispose of hazardous household materials such as used motor oil, paint, turpentine, acid or lye-based cleaners, household and car batteries, pesticides, pool chemicals and garden herbicides and e-waste such as VCRs, stereos, fax machines, copiers, computer keyboards and cellular telephones -- free of charge.

We would greatly appreciate any assistance you can provide in getting out word of this event. Enclosed is an event flyer for your information.
