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AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AGREEMENT NO. 20-020 APPROVED – KANE, BALLMER & BERKMAN; RESOLUTION NO. 20-118 ADOPTED – AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET. Staff report dated July 28, 2020, was presented recommending approval of Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. 20-020 with Kane, Ballmer & Berkman (“Special Counsel”) to provide legal services to the City, Successor Agency, Housing Authority and Parking Authority.

It was moved by Council Member/Successor Agency Member/Housing Authority Member/Parking Authority Member Morales, and seconded by Council Member/Successor Agency Member/Housing Authority Member/Parking Authority Member Franklin that the City Council/Successor Agency/Housing Authority/Parking Authority does hereby: 1) Approve Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. 20-20 in an amount not to exceed \$270,000 (bringing the total contract compensation to \$820,000); and 2) Approve the payment of outstanding invoices for special counsel’s legal services for the month of June 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.
