SUBJECT: Payment of Invoice No. 43 – Martin’s Cocina y Cantina

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Mayor and Council Members authorize payment of Invoice No. 43 to the Martin’s Cocina y Cantina, for catering services provided for the Taste of Inglewood Big Game Concert Series Festival event, in the amount of \$10,890. (General Fund)

BACKGROUND:

On Market Street, in Downtown Inglewood, the City of Inglewood held its Taste of Inglewood Big Game Concert Series Festival on Thursday, February 10, 2022, through Saturday, February 12, 2022. The Festival Concert Series attracted people from all over the nation, who came to Inglewood for the Super Bowl.

Essential elements to putting on a great concert series are ensuring that the performers and staff are hydrated and fed. Martin’s Cocina y Cantina was hired to provide necessary food and beverage services.

DISCUSSION:

Martin’s Cocina y Cantina is one of Inglewood’s premier businesses, specializing in upscale Mexican cuisine. On Thursday, February 10, 2022, foodservice was provided for over 220 guests, including the performers and their bands, dignitaries, VIPs, event staff workers, and the Operations of Emergency Joint Agencies. The foodservice was presented according to the protocols required by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health. Martin’s Cocina y Cantina provided a festive array of delicacies and beverages for the event. The Festival spotlighted the magnificence of the City in a vibe that brought the community together for a fun and joyful experience.




