SUBJECT: Modification to Staff Report – May 17, 2022
Departmental Reports Item No. DR-3

While conducting a review of the Public Works' staff report for the May 17, 2022, Council Agenda, an error was detected in Departmental Reports Item No. DR-3. On page 5, in the first paragraph of "FINANCIAL/FUNDING ISSUES AND SOURCES," the amount secured from California State Transportation Authority's Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program is shown as \$595 million; however, the correct amount should be listed as \$95 million.

That section of the report has been revised to read as follows:

To date, the City has secured a total of approximately \$350 million, of which \$95 million is from California State Transportation Authority's Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program; \$230 million from Metro Measure R Sales Tax Revenue; and an estimated \$25 million from existing and new projected City revenue streams.

Each shortlisted Responder, upon forming an integrated proposer team with an eligible transit technology supplier of their choice, will continue to the next step of the procurement process.

FINANCIAL/FUNDING ISSUES AND SOURCES:

To date, the City has secured a total of approximately \$350 million, of which **\$95 million** is from California State Transportation Authority's Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program; \$230 million from Metro Measure R Sales Tax Revenue; and an estimated \$25 million from existing and new projected City revenue streams.

In addition, the City is pursuing \$650 million from the Federal Transit Administration's Capital Investment Grant New Starts Program along with other federal and local sources. The City is also currently seeking \$400 million from the state budget through additional TIRCP grants, the Solutions for Congested Corridors Program with Caltrans and other anticipated state funds.
