**SUBJECT:** Acceptance of Grant Funds and Adoption of Budget Resolution

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Mayor and Council Members take the following actions:

1. Approve acceptance of the Lunch at the Library Program Grant funding from the California State Library in the amount of \$19,800;
2. Approve acceptance of the Día de los Niños Program (DIA) Grant funding from the Southern California Library Cooperative in the amount of \$1,000;
3. Approve acceptance of the Digital Literacy Grant from the California Public Utilities Commission in the amount of \$2,912;
4. Adopt the attached resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget to include grant funds. (General Fund)

**BACKGROUND:**

On July 14, 2022, the Inglewood Public Library received an award from the California State Library of \$19,800 in grant funds for the Lunch at the Library Program. Lunch at the Library is a project of the California State Library, supported with funds from the State of California. It was developed by the California Library Association and the California Summer Meal Coalition, with support from the David and Lucille Packard Foundation. This program provides funding to libraries to provide enrichment material to support local summer food programs.

On June 16, 2022, the Inglewood Public Library received an award from the Southern California Library Cooperative of \$1,000 in grant funds for the DIA Program. DIA is a program produced in collaboration with the California State Library to support and provide resources for multicultural and multilingual families.

On January 25, 2022, the Inglewood Public Library received an award amount of \$2,912 in grant funds from the California Public Utilities Commission for the funding of a Digital Literacy program. The Digital Literacy program is a part of a larger program, the Broadband Adoption Grant, which provides grant money to communities with limited access to broadband services.

**DISCUSSION:**

The Lunch at the Library Program Grant Funding will be used for the purposes of supporting and enhancing the Lunch at the Library provided by the City of Inglewood at the Crenshaw-Imperial Library and Pop-up library services at City Parks. DIA funding will allow the library to focus on inclusion and promote culture, language, and books to support a multicultural experience. The Digital Literacy funding will be used to offer computer education instruction, seat furnishings, and curriculum.

**FINANCIAL/FUNDING ISSUES AND SOURCES:**

Upon adoption of a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget, funds in the total amount of \$23,712 will be available under Account Code No. 001.050.5080.45100 (General Fund-Library-Extension-Program Expenses).


