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**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Mayor and Council Members authorize payment of an outstanding legal invoice submitted by the law firm of Cauvel & Dacey, P.C. ("Special Counsel") (Attorney-Client Privileged) in the amount of \$200. (General Fund)

**BACKGROUND:**

On September 10, 2021, the City of Inglewood (City) entered into Short Form Agreement No. 21-236 with Special Counsel for various legal services with respect to CIP Project P212 Century Boulevard Mobility Improvement Project and related matters. Short Form Agreement No. 21-236 terminated on December 31, 2022.

**DISCUSSION:**

Special Counsel has provided professional legal services as expected by the City under Short Form Agreement No. 21-236. Unfortunately, the services contemplated by the invoice were performed after Short Form Agreement No. 21-236 terminated. This staff report seeks authority to pay an outstanding invoice for services performed (during January 2023) after the termination of Short Form Agreement No. 21-236.


