**SUBJECT:** Acceptance of FY 2019 – 2020 COPS Option Grant Funds

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Mayor and Council Members take the following actions:

1. Accept State Citizens Option for Public Safety (COPS Option) grant funds in the amount of \$170,572;
2. Approve the expenditure recommendations of the Chief of Police;
3. Authorize inclusion of remaining COPS Option grant funds from the previous fiscal year in the amount of \$137,961; and
4. Adopt the attached resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2019 – 2020 budget to include said funds.

**BACKGROUND:**

Under the provisions of Assembly Bill 3229, the City has received \$170,572 from the State of California's COPS grant program. Pursuant to the terms of this measure, funds are provided to counties and cities on a per capita basis for law enforcement capital outlay supporting the front-line duties of the Police Department's sworn personnel.

The City has received these funds since the 1996 – 1997 fiscal year. The State requires that local citizens are given an opportunity to provide input and discuss the expenditure recommendations of the Chief of Police. According to the guidelines, these funds can be used for various purposes supporting the efforts of front-line police officers including: equipment, supplies, training, consultant services, public service announcements, and recruitment efforts.

**DISCUSSION:**

After assessing the needs of the Police Department, the Chief of Police recommends that COPS Option Grant Funds are allocated for the following expenditures:

**Video Downlink** **\$65,000**

The Department regularly receives mutual aid assistance in the form of air support from other law enforcement agencies located within the area. Aircrafts providing air support are usually equipped with a video camera that is capable of feeding live video to personnel on the ground. In order for local personnel to receive this video feed, a video downlink is necessary. The Department will use a total of \$65,000 in COPS Option Grant Funds to purchase video downlink equipment.

**Drone Program** **\$55,000**

In recent years, several law enforcement agencies across the country have increased the use of drones to conduct law enforcement activities. Drones offer a cost-effective method for law enforcement personnel to obtain an overhead view while conducting various law enforcement operations. If approved, the Department will use a total of \$55,000 in COPS Option Grant Funds to establish a drone program. These funds will be specifically used for hardware, software, training, and other fees associated with the program.

**Non-POST/Non-Reimbursable Training** **\$50,572**

A total of \$50,572 will be used to purchase training for sworn and civilian personnel that is not POST reimbursable. The selected training will concentrate on various areas including, but not limited to: resource management, personnel evaluations, incident management, less-lethal tactics, and supervisory/managerial accountability. Funds in this category will be used to purchase any supplies, equipment, or services required to participate in such training.

In addition to the aforementioned expenditure requests, it is recommended that City Council authorizes the inclusion of \$137,961 in COPS Option grant funds remaining from the previous fiscal year. These funds will be specifically used for purchases that were previously approved by City Council. Any new expenditure will be vetted through the City's normal procurement process.

**FINANCIAL/FUNDING ISSUES AND SOURCES:**

No matching funds are required for receipt of COPS Option grant funds. Upon adoption of the resolution to accept the grant funds and authorization to include the prior year's unexpended grant funding, monies will be deposited into account code no. 226.045.4562 (Public Safety Grant Fund – Police – COPS Option) as described in Attachment No. 3 (Budget Exhibit).



Dear Controller Yee:

Pursuant to Government Code section 30029.05, subdivision (e), paragraph (2), the Department of Finance respectfully submits the attached (Attachments I and II) percentages for the 2019-20 allocation of \$214,200,000 in Citizens' Option for Public Safety (COPS) and Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) funds deposited in the Enhancing Law Enforcement Activities Subaccount (ELEAS) in the Law Enforcement Services Account within the Local Revenue Fund 2011.

Pursuant to Government Code section 30061, subdivisions (b) and (g), subsequent to the allocation described in Section 29552, subdivision (d), 47.08727192 percent of the remaining funds deposited in the ELEAS for the COPS (23.54363596 percent) and JJCPA (23.54363596 percent) programs are to be allocated, according to the relative population for each county and city, as follows:

- (1) 5.15 percent to county sheriffs for county jail construction and operation (\$11,031,300).
- (2) 5.15 percent to district attorneys for criminal prosecution (\$11,031,300).
- (3) 50 percent to counties to implement a comprehensive multi-agency juvenile justice plan (\$107,100,000).
- (4) 39.7 percent to counties and cities for front-line law enforcement (\$85,037,400). Note that pursuant to Government Code section 30061, subdivision (b), paragraph (3), each law enforcement jurisdiction receiving front-line law enforcement funding is to receive a minimum grant of \$100,000. The percentages included in Attachment II are calculated in a manner that provides for a minimum grant allocation of \$100,000 to each law enforcement jurisdiction listed in Attachment II.

Note that the by-county percentages for the first three allocations above: (1) county jail construction and operation, (2) district attorney criminal prosecution, and (3) multi-agency juvenile justice plans, are specified on Attachment I and the by-county/city percentages for the fourth allocation, front-line law enforcement, are identified on Attachment II.
