- a. A resident from District 4 inquired about neighborhood parking and the Citywide Parking Permit Program. The residents' concerns were that the program is unfair, costly, and not enough is applied to protect residents' privacy. City staff provided background information on the program and explained how to initiate an amendment to the program. It was reported that the main corridors do not have a parking permit restriction.
- b. Another issue discussed was the vehicle's speed and racing on the north side of 118th Street and Crenshaw Boulevard in the late hours of the day. Unfortunately, it isn't easy to monitor and track such cases. The Commander of the Traffic Unit informed the resident that the City had developed a unit to handle these types of cases. California Highway Patrol and the City of Inglewood are on board to avoid speeding. The dispatch enforcement phone line; (310) 412-8732, was given for the resident to contact and report from a vehicle parked in the alley during the sweeping time to unsafe speed vehicles.
- c. Excessive red curbs on Evergreen Street is another topic discussed. City staff provided information on the justification of the need for red curbs. The determining factor depends on the sight distance for the vehicle to turn, the location of a fire hydrant, the opening of the catch basin, the tips of the ends of the driveways, the curb is less than 20 feet long between the driveways, and will there be enough space for emergency vehicles to park. The resident was recommended to contact the Department of Public Works for a field inspection evaluation since it is a case-by-case scenario.
