PERMITTEE AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING

1. Request inspections from the City of Inglewood, Public Works Department, 24 hours in advance by telephoning (310) 412-5333
2. All work performed under this permit shall conform to the current edition of the "Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction" stated on this permit.
3. All construction materials, debris and run-off, shall be contained within the work area and not allowed into storm drain systems.
4. Traffic control shall be established and maintained as prescribed by the "Work Area Traffic Control Handbook."
5. Notice shall be given to the Inglewood Communication's Center by telephoning (310) 412-5251 (24 hours) in advance of performing any work which will encroach any traffic lane.
6. The minimum thickness for reconstruction of street pavement sectional shall be as follows:

MAJOR STREET: A.C. or conc. pavement 1" greater than existing, 8" min. & 12" aggregate base min.

MINOR STREETS: A.C. or conc. pavement 1" greater than existing, 6"min. & 8" aggregate base min.
