## Essential **Actions**

- 1** Learn the threats in your area
- 2** Identify meeting places
  - Outside your home
  - Outside your neighborhood
- 3** Select your out-of-state contact
- 4** Know your evacuation routes
  - Exits and alternate way to leave home
- 5** Know the location of utility shut-offs
  - Water
  - Gas
  - Electricity
- 6** Know the emergency policies of schools and adult-care centers
  - Emergency shelter/supplies
  - Transportation
- 7** Identify safe spots in each room to take cover, if needed
  - Under sturdy tables and desks
  - Against interior walls
- 8** Extra medications
- 9** Make special provisions for
  - Children
  - Seniors
  - Pets
  - People with disabilities
  - Non-English Speaking
- 10** Schedule annual disaster drills
