FACT SHEET

CANNABIS BUSINESS IS NOT PERMITTED!

The City of Inglewood prohibits commercial and medical cultivation, sale, distribution, and dispensation of cannabis, except cannabis sold or dispensed from an inpatient medical facility that has secured a Special Use Permit, such as a hospital or hospice. Possession and indoor home cultivation by adults over 21 for personal use is allowed, subject to State of California law.

What is the new State law?

In California, it is now legal for adults over 21 years of age to use cannabis for medical and recreational reasons at home. Adults can possess up to 28.5 grams of cannabis, and grow up to 6 plants inside their home.

Can you buy or sell recreational cannabis in the City of Inglewood?

No. Inglewood does not allow the commercial distribution or sale of cannabis.

Can you grow your own cannabis in the City of Inglewood?

Yes, if you are an adult over 21 years old, you can legally grow up to six cannabis plants inside your home for personal use at home. You may not grow cannabis for sale.

Can you buy or sell medical cannabis in a dispensary in Inglewood?

No, the sale of "medical marijuana" at dispensaries is not permitted in Inglewood.

Are there any exceptions?

Yes, the only medical distribution of cannabis that could be permitted in Inglewood is for a patient of an inpatient medical facility, like a hospital or hospice, subject to Special Use Permit approval by the City.

Where can I learn more about the rules in Inglewood?

The City of Inglewood Municipal Code, Chapter 12, Article 34 states the specific rules regarding cannabis in Inglewood.

History of California and Inglewood laws regarding cannabis:
