ATTEMPT TO LOCATE VEHICLE



Not actual vehicles, similar only

SUSPECT VEHICLE:

Mid-1990's Honda CR-V, silver

UPDATE:

On Saturday, February 1, 2020, at approximately 11:30 PM, Inglewood Police Officers responded to the area of 84th Place and Van Ness Avenue regarding a traffic collision involving a vehicle versus pedestrian.

Upon arrival, Officers located an unresponsive pedestrian in the southbound lanes of Van Ness Avenue. The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital. Multiple injuries sustained to the injuries sustained as a result of the collision.

The driver of the vehicle that struck the pedestrian fled the scene and is still at large. The suspect vehicle is described as a mid-1990's, 4-door, Honda CRV, silver in color. The vehicle sustained front end/windshield damage consistent with striking a pedestrian.
