FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION

On February 10, 2020, at approximately 4:40 PM, Inglewood Police Officers responded to the area of Centinela Avenue and Florence Avenue in regards to a multi-vehicle collision that occurred in the intersection within the City of Inglewood.

Upon arrival, officers located a total of five vehicles involved. Several of those vehicles were fully engulfed in flames as a result of the collision. The flames were extinguished by Los Angeles County Fire personnel. Injured parties were treated at the scene by LACO Fire personnel and transported to a local hospital for further medical treatment. Unfortunately, one of the drivers involved in this collision succumbed to injuries sustained as a result of the collision. No other information will be released at this time, pending next of kin notification.

At this time, the cause of the traffic collision has not been determined and remains under investigation.
