HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION – SUSPECT IN CUSTODY

On March 19, 2020, at 11:59 AM, the Inglewood Police Department received a radio call of a stabbing victim at 420 E. Florence Avenue in the City of Inglewood. Officers were dispatched to the location and located a male, later identified as Andrew Pozos age 22, with a stab wound. Los Angeles County Fire Department responded to the scene and transported the victim to the Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center, where he was subsequently pronounced dead.

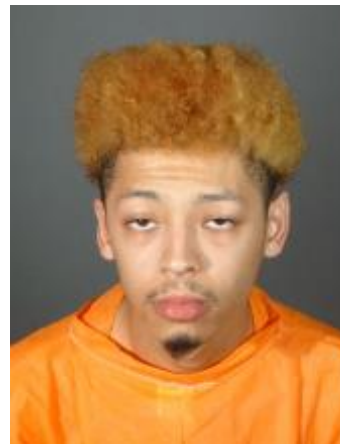
The investigation revealed that the suspect, in this case, was Nathan Jamal Snodgrass, age 21, an Inglewood resident. Snodgrass turned himself into the Hawthorne Police Department where he was ultimately taken into custody by Inglewood Police Officers for the murder of Pozos.

On March 23, 2020, the case was presented to the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office and Nathan Snodgrass was charged with murder (187 P.C.). His bail was set at \$2,020,000.00. Refer to DA case #YA101813.
