

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-04

ORDER OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA MANDATING ALL PERSONS IN THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD TO WEAR A FACE COVERING WHEN INTERACTING WITH OTHERS WHO ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THEIR HOUSEHOLD IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SPACES RECITALS

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the City of Inglewood issued a Proclamation of Existence of a Local Emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, during a local emergency the City Council may promulgate orders and regulations necessary to provide for the protection of life and property.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Inglewood, California, as follows:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are incorporated into this Order.

SECTION 2. This order is promulgated to provide for the protection of life and property, pursuant to Government Code Section 8634.

SECTION 3. Everyone in Inglewood is directed to wear a face covering when they are interacting with others who are not members of their household in public and private spaces. Face coverings are an additional tool that individuals should use to help slow the spread of covid-19, but does not replace other social distancing requirements.
