**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Tuesday, March 15, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. at the Inglewood City Hall Council Chambers, One West Manchester Blvd. 9<sup>th</sup> Floor, Inglewood, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and discuss draft Council District Maps submitted, and receive and file public comments.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 21622(a)(3), the City must adopt its final map of the council district's boundaries by April 17, 2022, as the City's next regular municipal election will be held on November 8, 2022. Adhering to this public hearing will ensure the City has enough time to adopt the final map by April 5, 2022.

Due to the existing COVID-19 health emergency and the social distancing measures currently in effect, and pursuant to Assembly Bill 361, please note that members of the public will be allowed only to observe and address the City Council Meeting of March 15, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. by telephone, video and other electronic means.
