Subject: Re-Districting: Changes needed to District 1 and 2

Dear City of Inglewood Staff,

I had not received public notice until Jan 28, 2022, and was unable to attend Jan29 due to chemo side effects.

I request that the-section of District 1 North of Florence Avenue be re-assigned to District 2, as District 2 has been our historical home.

When we were moved from District 2 in 2016, the requirements under the Fair Maps Act were not followed.

As stated in 10-26-21 City of Inglewood Document regarding Public Hearing to Receive Public Input Regarding Redistricting:

“2. The geographic integrity of any local neighborhood or local community of interest shall be respected in a manner that minimizes division. A “community of interest” is a population that shares common social or economic interests that should be included within a single district for purposes of its effective and fair representation. Communities of Interest do not include relationships with political parties, incumbents, or political candidates.

3. Council district boundaries should be easily identifiable and understandable by residents. Council district boundaries shall be bounded by natural and artificial barriers (rives, highways, light rail, etc.) by streets or by the boundaries of the city.

4. Where it does not conflict with the preceding criteria, council districts shall be drawn to encourage geographical compactness in a manner that nearby areas of population are not bypassed in favor of more distant populations. (Elections Code Section 21621(c)(1)-(4).)

I request information for the next two public hearings on this topic, which I see on your Jan 5, 2022 Document, are scheduled for Feb 22, 2022, and March 15, 2022.

I am circulating a petition amongst my neighbors which I shall present at the next public hearing.

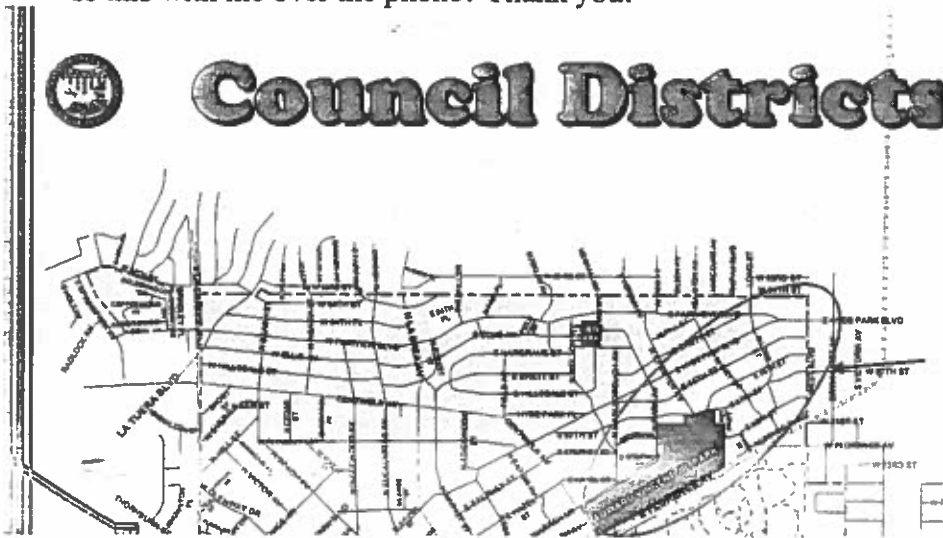
