Re: Map Redistricting Draft

This Map Proposal is equally divided, creating each district to represent 25% of Inglewood's population. This map has been drafted in accordance with the rules of the Fair Maps Act. Therefore, it is geographically contiguous, the boundaries are easily identifiable and understandable to residents, and all common social and economic interests of our neighborhoods and community have been considered. We believe that in order to have fair and effective representation in Inglewood, this map should be approved as the new District Map for the City of Inglewood.

The boundaries of this map are largely the same with only a minor change to make the level of representation equal through every district. This map divides District 1 to allot 26,435 residents, equating to 25% of our population. District 2 comprises of 26,975 residents, equaling 25% of our population. District 3 has 27,210 residents, making up another 25% of our population. Lastly, District 4 is represented by 27,142 residents, bringing the final percentage to 25% as well. These numbers encompass the City of Inglewood's total population.
