**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING  
RESOLUTION 22-84 AND ADOPTING A NEW  
RESOLUTION LISTING PROJECTS FUNDED BY SB 1:  
THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF  
2017, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-23.**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must adopt by resolution listing all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, will receive an estimated \$2,511,037 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2022-23 from SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the sixth year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding. Receipt of said funding will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation of public streets, roads and sidewalks, add active transportation infrastructure, improve drainage infrastructure, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

**WHEREAS**, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project

1 list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects  
2 that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of maintain and rehabilitate four  
4 arterials by improving sidewalk, drainage infrastructure and increasing mobility options  
5 throughout the City this year and hundreds of similar projects into the future; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment  
7 found that the City streets and roads are in an "at risk" condition and this revenue will help us  
8 increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets  
9 and roads into a "good" condition; and

10 **WHEREAS**, on May 24, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No.: 22-84 which  
11 also adopted a list of projects for SB 1 funding; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Resolution No.: 22-84 needs to be rescinded and a new SB 1 funding  
13 resolution adopted.

14 **NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA,**  
15 **DOES HEREBY RESOLVED TO:**

16 **Section 1.** Insert the foregoing recitals hereby by this reference as if set  
17 forth in full herein.

18 **Section 2.** Rescind Resolution No.: 22-84 and adopt this resolution in its  
19 place.


