Public Records Request FAQ

Q: How do I access the form?

Public Records Requests can be emailed, faxed, mailed, or dropped off in person

Q: How long until I receive the documents I am requesting?

A: The department has 10 days to respond. If additional time is needed, they are allotted 14 additional days

Q: Is there a way to expedite my request?

A: Due to the amount of requests received, the City Clerk's Office is unable to expedite any requests.
