

1 **ORDINANCE No. 15-08**

2 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD,**
3 **CALIFORNIA REVISING CHAPTER 3 OF THE**
4 **MUNICIPAL CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY**
5 **COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH BY RESOLUTION**
6 **CERTAIN FEES FOR USING MUNICIPAL PARKING**
7 **LOTS AND STRUCTURES.**

8 **WHEREAS,** on October 1, 2013, the Inglewood City Council established a
9 Master Fee Schedule where fees for municipal services can be added, deleted or revised
10 by resolution of the City Council; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the City Council wishes to add fees for parking in municipal
12 parking lots and structures to the Master Fee Schedule.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
14 **INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

15 **SECTION 1.** Inglewood Municipal Code section 3-89 is hereby repealed.

16 ~~“Section 3-89. Public Parking Lots and Structures.~~

17 ~~Parking meters of the type described in this Article may be installed in any~~
18 ~~publicly operated and owned parking lot or parking structure. For publicly owned parking~~
19 ~~lots or parking structures which do not have parking meters, other than Parking Structure~~
20 ~~2, the rate shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month or one dollar (\$1.00) per half hour, or~~
21 ~~portion thereof, up to a maximum of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per day unless~~
22 ~~free or validated parking is provided. For Parking Structure 2, unless free or validated~~
23 ~~parking is provided, the rate shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00) per month, six dollars (\$6.00)~~
24 ~~per day, or seventy five cents (\$.75) per half hour.”~~

25 **SECTION 2.** Inglewood Municipal Code section 3-64 is hereby amended as follows:

26 **“Section 3-64. Municipal Parking Lots. Regulations.**

27 (1) The City of Inglewood may regulate the utilization of parking lots and
28 structures, inclusive of parking structures, that are accessible to the motoring public and

1 are owned or operated by the City of Inglewood, or are operated under a cooperative
2 agreement between the City and other public agency, including, but not limited to, the
3 installation and/or use of parking meters, parking attendants to collect parking fees, and
4 signs specifying any limitations on the time duration or the days of the week when
5 vehicles may be parked and any other conditions on the use of a City parking lot. Such
6 regulation shall be conducted under the authority of the Public Works Director of the
7 City of Inglewood.

8 (2) A City parking lot may be closed or partially closed to vehicular access
9 whenever it is utilized for a limited period of time for a special event conducted or
10 sponsored by the City or by community organizations and the like, if such closure is
11 authorized by the Public Works Director or designee.

12 (3) The City Council may establish, by resolution, any fees for parking in
13 municipal parking lots and structures. Such fees may be specified in a Master Fee
14 Schedule.”

15 **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, subdivision,
16 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person
17 or circumstance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or
18 unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining sections,
19 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this ordinance,
20 or its application to any other person or circumstance. The City of Inglewood hereby
21 declares that it would have adopted each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,
22 sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the
23 sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases hereof be
24 declared invalid or unenforceable.

25 **SECTION 4.** The City Clerk shall certify to the approval, passage and adoption
26 of this Ordinance by the City Council and shall cause the same to be published in
27 accordance with the City Charter; and thirty days from the final passage and adoption,
28 this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect.
