SUBJECT: Termination of Integrated Solid Waste Management Services Agreement with Waste Management of Los Angeles

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Mayor and Council Members authorize the Mayor to provide a 30-day written termination notice to Waste Management of Los Angeles (WMLA), terminating Integrated Solid Waste Management Services Agreement No. 04-142, effective August 1, 2012.

BACKGROUND

The City of Inglewood (City) had a seven-year franchise agreement with WMLA for the collection, removal and disposal of municipal solid waste generated by residential and commercial/industrial customers in the city. The franchise agreement was set to expire on November 20, 2011.

On July 12, 2011, the City Council, pursuant to Section 2.5 of Agreement No. 04-142, extended the term of the agreement on a month-to-month basis (beginning on December 1, 2011) for a maximum of twelve (12) months. Subsequent to that action, the City conducted a Request for Proposal process to solicit bids for a new multi-year agreement.

On February 23, 2012, the City Council received testimony and presentations from companies that submitted responsive proposals. Each company provided an overview of their operations and proposed rates, answered questions from the City Council and responded to comments received from the public. WMLA and Consolidated Disposal Services (CDS) were among the companies that made presentations.

On June 5, 2012, the City Council approved a 10-year agreement with CDS. CDS' proposal calls for services to commence on August 1, 2012.

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to Section 2.5 of the Integrated Solid Waste Management Services Agreement with WMLA, the City has the right to terminate the agreement provided that a 30-day

notice is given. Therefore, it is requested that the City Council authorize the Mayor to provide the requisite notice of termination in accordance with Section 2.5 of the Integrated Solid Waste Agreement.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

Timely notice provided to WMLA is required, per the Agreement. If approved, a letter under the Mayor's signature will be sent to WMLA in accordance with the termination of notice requirement listed in the agreement.
