Seismic (earth quake) upgrade	\$ 250,000
Repair Elevators	\$ 600,000
ADA Compliant Restrooms	\$ 900,000
Relocate Council Chambers to 1st floor - Evac.Safety	\$ 1,500,000
Subtotal	\$ 4,350,000

Inglewood Library

Seismic Upgrade	\$ 1,200,000
ADA Compliant Restrooms	\$ 520,000
Repair Elevator	\$ 100,000
Subtotal	\$ 1,820,000

Parking Structure

Seismic Upgrade	\$ 800,000
ADA Upgrades	\$ 350,000
Subtotal	\$ 1,150,000

Police Facility

The Police Facility has not been evaluated to determine seismic and other structural needs. Given the age and observable deterioration of the structure, a rough estimate is:
